



## **Recommended Equipment List**

During class, we discuss the following equipment in great detail – ie. Which ones to get and which ones to DEFINITELY NOT get. Here is a follow-up sheet for past GCBA students to remind them of the basics.

### Basic Face Painting Kit - “Must Haves”

- White face/body paint (wax based linework brand, as discussed in class)
- Black face/body paint (wax based linework brand, as discussed in class)
- Black face/body paint (creamy blending brand, as discussed in class)
- Plus face/body paint in the following colours at a minimum:
  - Yellow
  - Orange
  - Red
  - Pink (both pale pink and magenta if the budget allows)
  - Purple
  - Blue (both pale dark blue if the budget allows)
  - Green (both lime green and bottle green if the budget allows)
  - Brown
- The following brushes at a minimum (exact types discussed in class):
  - # 2 Round
  - # 4 Round
  - One inch flat
  - Quarter or half inch flat
  - Half inch chisel
- Face painting sponges
- Puff glitter (ONLY those discussed in class)
- Hand sanitiser (best type as discussed in class)
- Mirror

### Basic Face Painting Kit - “Nice to Haves”

- stencils
- one strokes/rainbow cakes
- split cakes
- liquid glitter gel
- Face/body paints in a range of other colours
- UV face/body paints
- Pearl face/body paints
- bling, gems and adhesives
